



Attention Air Quality Subcommittee Members:

There are two updates we wanted to make sure you are aware of:

- First, the state of Colorado developed a [Draft Climate Equity Framework](#) to help ensure that Colorado's response to climate change is guided by principles of racial equity and economic justice. The framework outlines the Air Pollution Control Division's plan to identify and meaningfully engage with communities who are disproportionately impacted by climate change in Colorado. The draft framework has been developed with input from community members, organizations that serve disproportionately impacted communities, local governments with climate equity and community engagement expertise, other state agencies, and EPA environmental justice experts.
  - Comments may be submitted through this form, [Feedback form](#), and are due by March 4th, 2021.
- Second, in response to the "Climate Action Plan to Reduce Pollution", [House Bill 19-1261](#), and the [Greenhouse Gas Pollution Reduction Roadmap](#), the division has commenced a process to develop rules to address greenhouse gas emissions from the oil and gas industry. They are holding a public listening session and a stakeholder meeting in March. The details and registration links are as follows:
