# Quarterly Jobs Report

Q2 2024



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# Introduction

The [Colorado Chamber of Commerce](#) and [Aspen Tech Labs](#) (ATL) have partnered to provide quarterly data on Colorado's workforce statistics and trends. Utilizing ATL's database of more than 9 million job vacancies worldwide from over 170,000 companies, these reports are meant to provide big-picture data to highlight key insights on Colorado's economy.

## Quarterly Benchmark: Q2 2024 Job Market Data

The upward trend from last quarter continued into Q2 2024. The number of job vacancies in Colorado increased by 1.9% between the beginning and end of the period. This was 1.5% more growth than the U.S. as a whole and a larger increase than in 33 other states. Denver saw the largest absolute increase, while Boulder had the largest percentage increase in vacancies. Internship opportunities substantially decreased, while apprenticeships remained steady.

Wages decreased slightly in Q2, with a 1.4% decrease in the median full-time salary from April 1, 2024. Part-time wages saw a slight decrease as well. However, Colorado rose one spot in the median salary by state rankings, from number 14 to number 13. Healthcare-related jobs dominated the highest-paying jobs list, making up 50% of the top 10. The Steamboat Springs Core-Based Statistical Area (CBSA) retained the highest part-time median salary, and Denver-Aurora-Centennial remained the CBSA with the highest full-time median salary.

## What's New:

As part of a new initiative, we present the Industry Spotlight section (see page 10), dedicated to exploring the latest trends and developments shaping various sectors within the Colorado economy. This quarter highlights Artificial Intelligence jobs in Colorado. In the U.S., there are 34% more AI jobs today compared to one year ago. While Colorado is lagging with just a 3% year-over-year increase in AI jobs, there is no doubt more and more companies are looking for AI talent. This section explores these trends in more detail, including top companies hiring for AI and top job titles.

## Data Notes:

The jobs data used in the Job Market Pulse platform comes directly from ATL's JobsIndex, which is the largest pool of organic jobs collected directly from corporate career sites and applicant tracking systems. With Job Market Pulse, customers use real-time jobs data to make critical business and competitive decisions. As in previous reports, we excluded employers that were added to our database during the quarter.

Given the breadth and diversity of the Job Market Pulse, ATL's data is geographically representative and covers all industries. The coverage of Job Market Pulse has and will continue to grow in 2024.

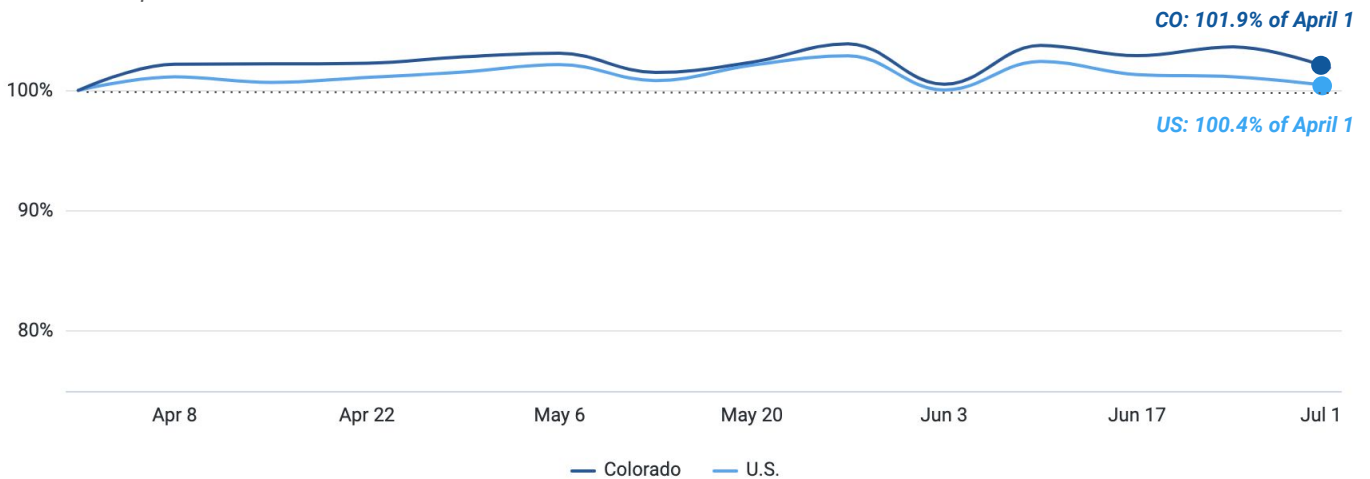

### Q2 2024 Average Weekly Vacancy Inflow

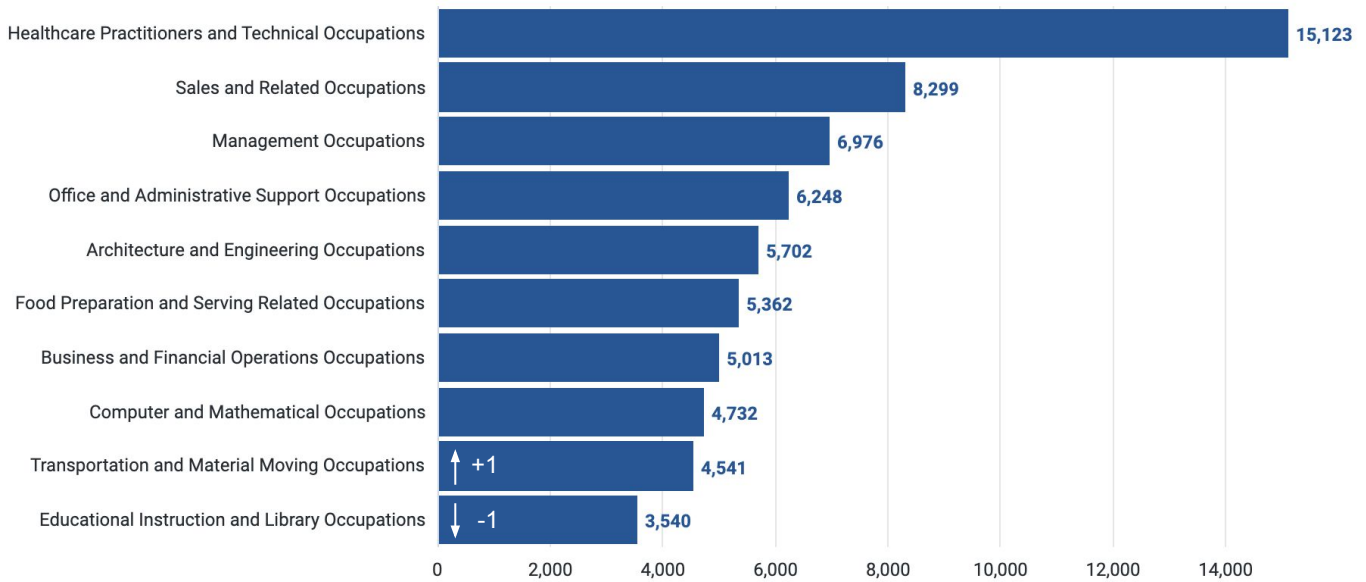

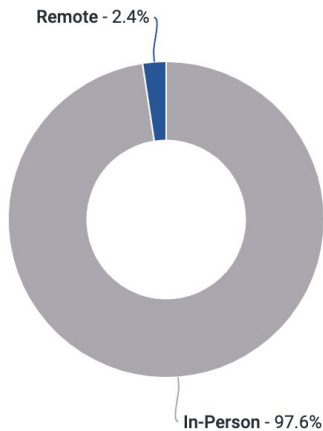

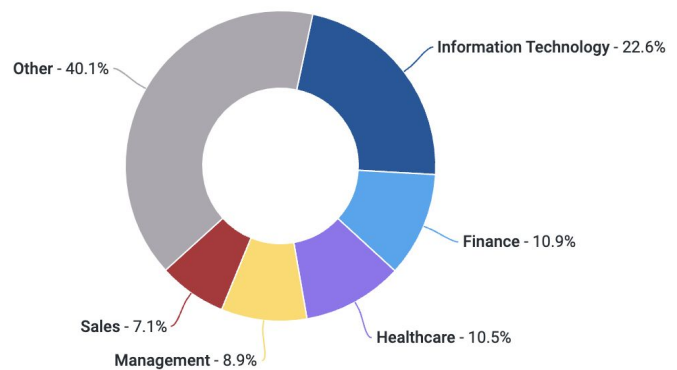

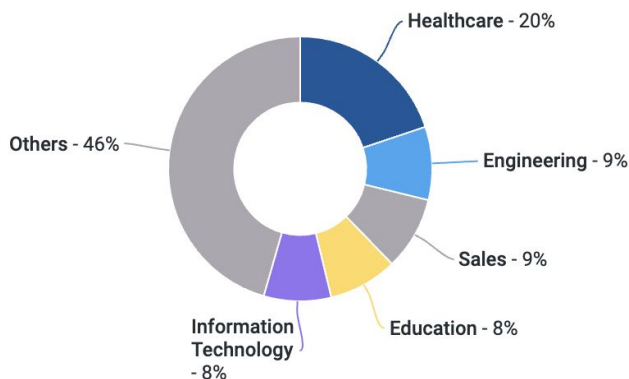

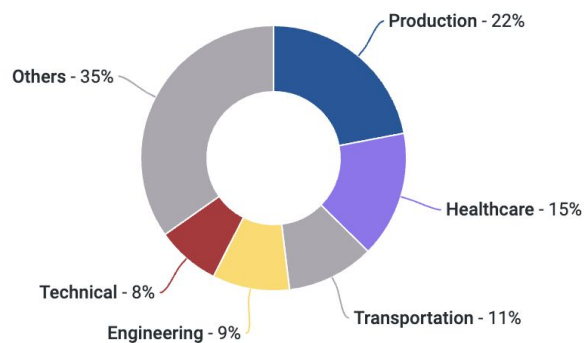

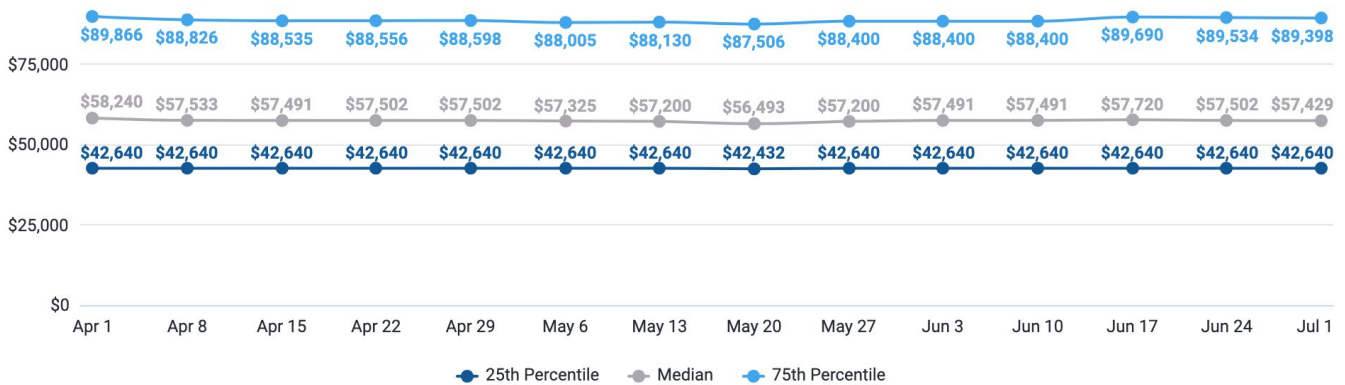

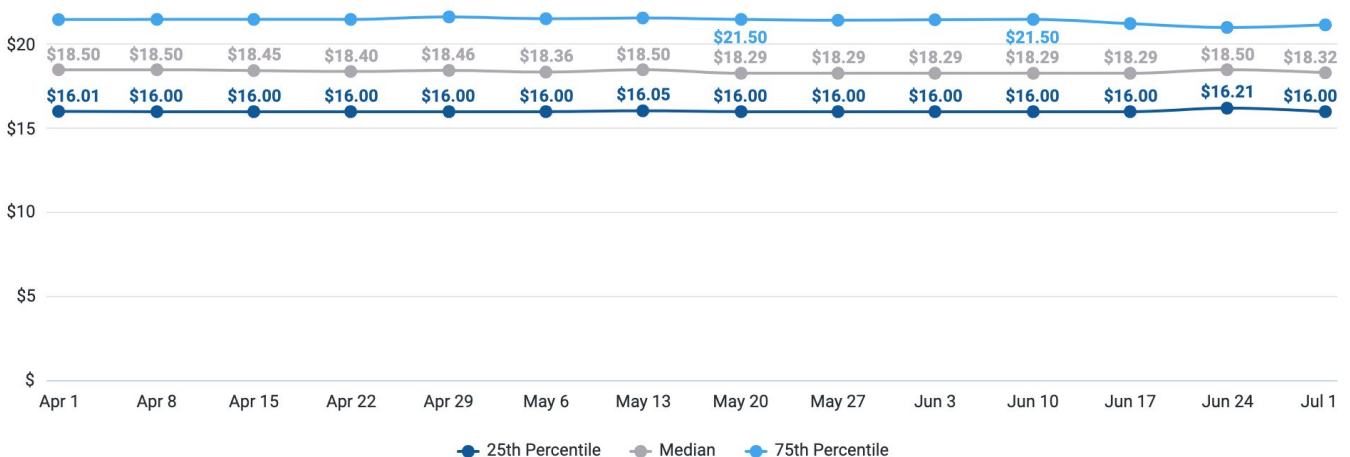

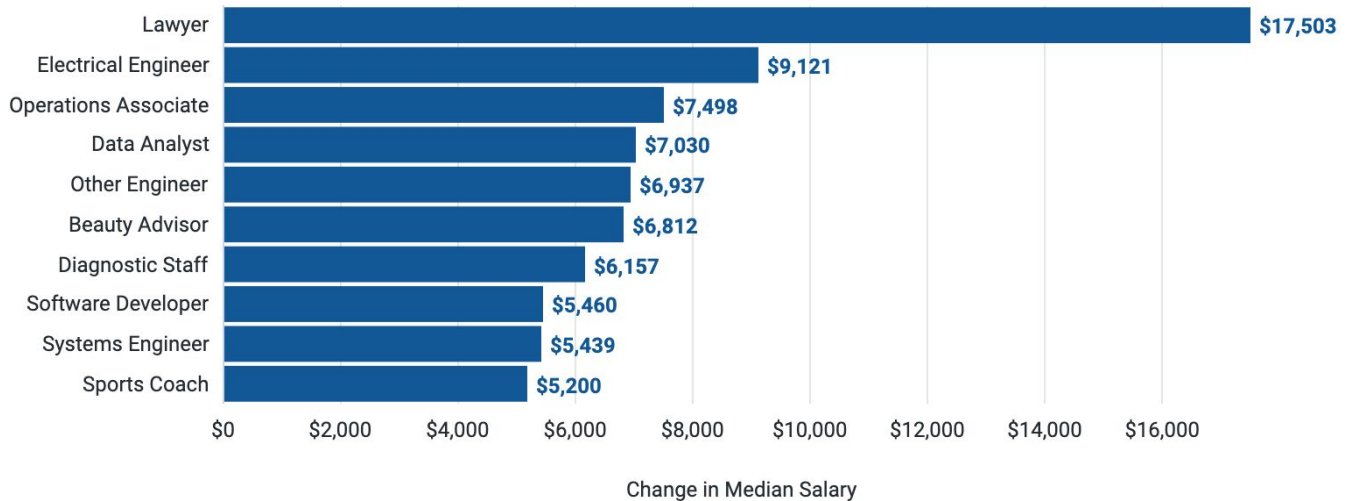

## Largest Median Salary Increases by Job Title

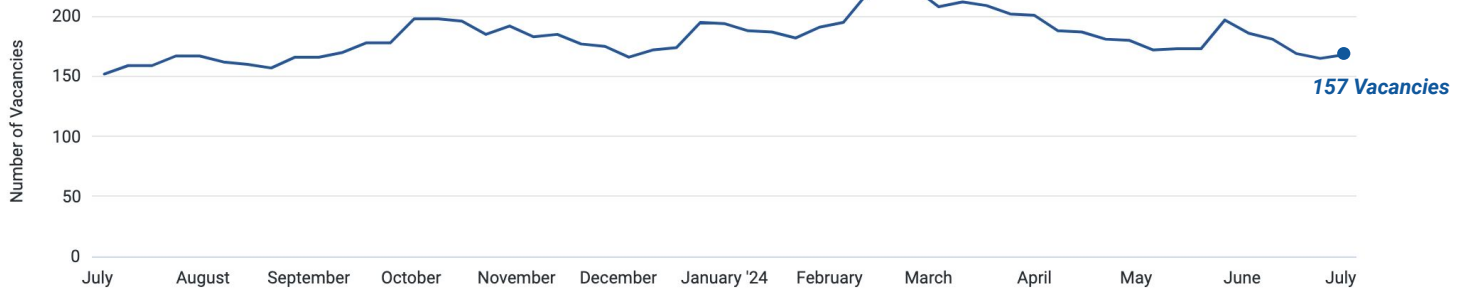

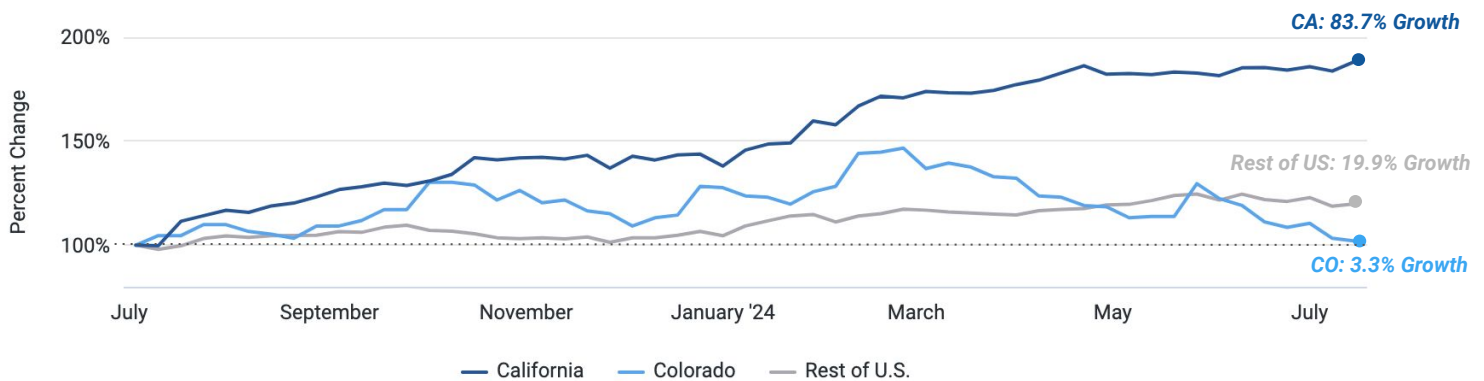
## Yearly Vacancy Trend

Weekly vacancy totals; the U.S. saw 34% total growth and 19.9% excluding CO and CA



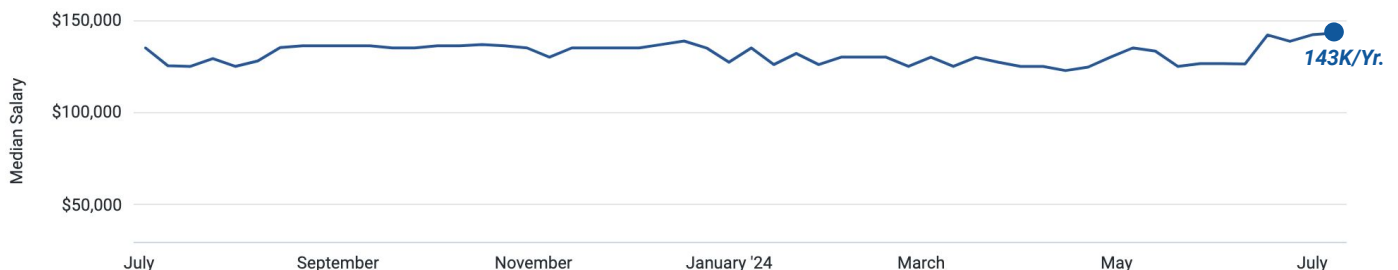

Weekly Vacancy Totals



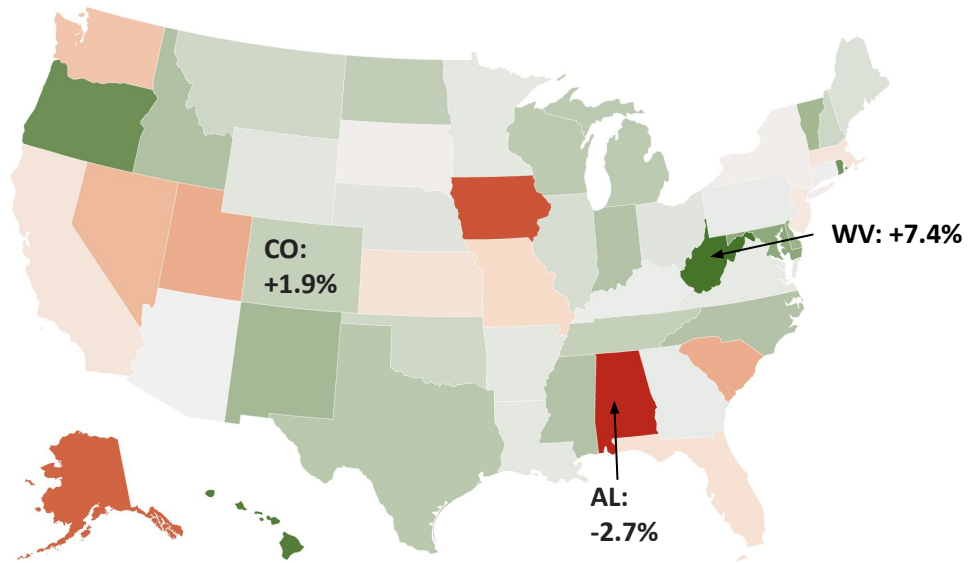

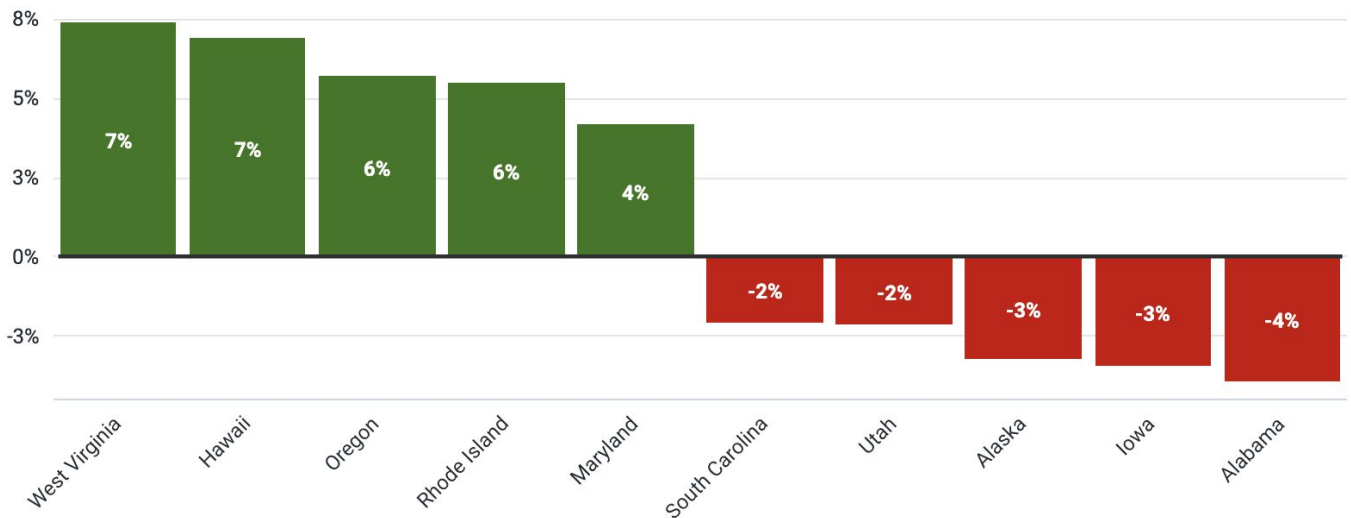

Vacancy Percent Change by State

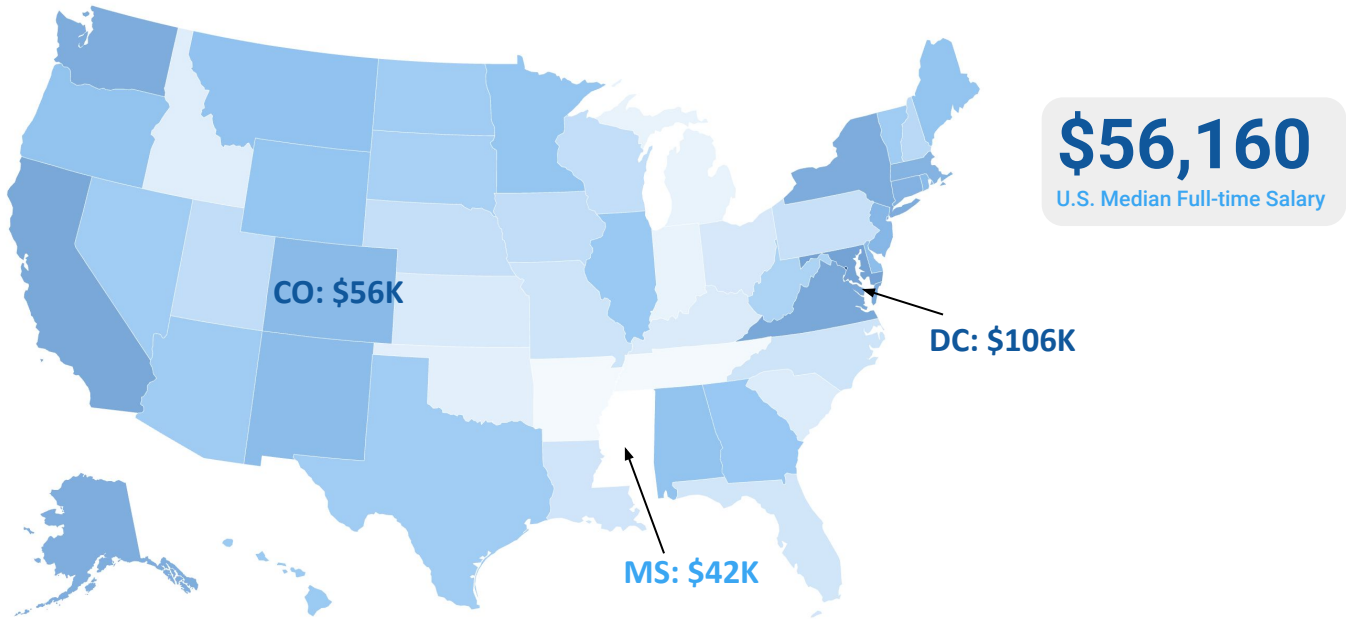


Top and Bottom States by Vacancy Percent Change

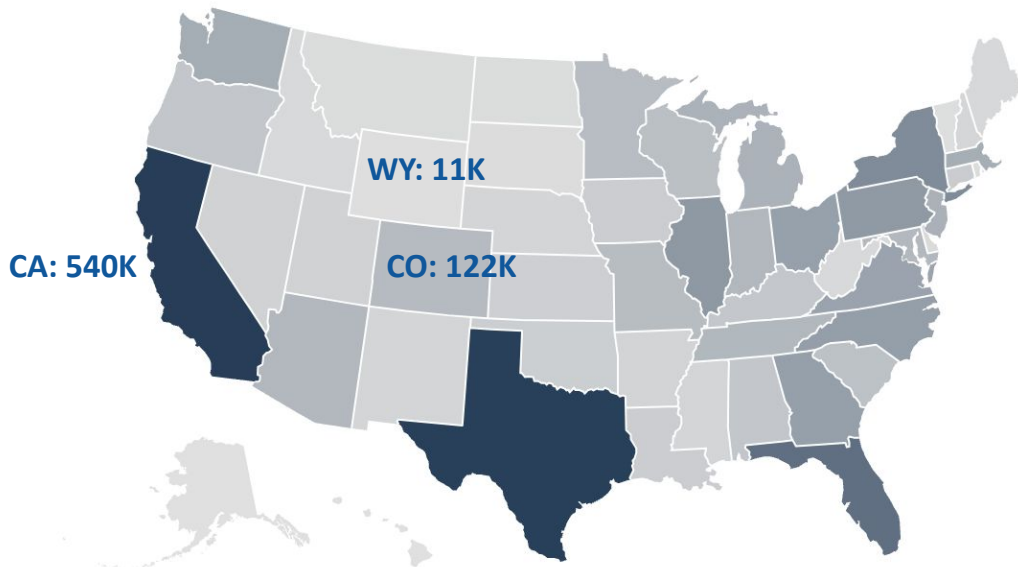
