

Colorado Option Rulemaking Well Under Way

The Colorado Option rulemaking stakeholder meetings started in late July. Today marked the fourth of six meetings hosted by the Division of Insurance (DOI) staff, which are intended to gain public feedback on the plan design and cost sharing. Today the DOI announced the Colorado Option Director, Kyla Hoskins. She has a background in program implementation and consumer advocacy, and will oversee the process under DOI and Commissioner Conway.

In addition to the announcement of the Colorado Option Director, the staff rolled out the first draft of the standardized plan options. The standardized plan options will be tiered the same as the Exchange program: Gold, Silver and Bronze plans, and the proposals can be viewed [here](#). This was the first of two meetings to review the proposed standardized plans. The next meeting will be Friday October 8th, and the final Colorado Option standardized plan will be shared on Thursday November 4th.
