OBJECTIVES:

Leveraging Business: It is primarily up to businesses to develop, finance and build the infrastructure to improve our environment. Bringing businesses and government together to collaborate on creative and solutions is key.

Policy Maker Education: Businesses are using innovative technological solutions to mitigate emissions. Awareness of those efforts among policymakers and regulators is critical for future regulatory actions.

Supportive Policy Solutions: Promoting flexible, not one-size-fits-all, policies will allow for more innovation and environmental progress.



GOALS OF THE TASK FORCE

Coalition Building

The Colorado Chamber will convene employers, operators and policy experts interested in the intersection between public policy and environmental sustainability.

Expert Facilitation

We will engage a facilitator with an expertise in environmental policy to help facilitate the discussion and establish a strategic framework for the Task Force.

Establish Principles

The Task Force will identify through collaboration and common ground a set of principles on climate policies and environmental sustainability.

Climate Innovations Led by Businesses

The Task Force will identify emissions-reduction technologies that businesses have invested in and incorporated into their operations for improving the environment.

Advocacy

The Task Force will identify, develop and advocate for proactive policies that allow businesses to effectively meet environmental sustainability expectations.

Partnership with Government

The Task Force will partner with policymakers on a balanced approach for the domestic production of resources that are critical in creating a sustainable environment.

Education

We will educate policymakers, regulators and the public on the sustainability and innovation efforts undertaken by businesses through sharing of data, best practices and information.

Awareness

We will share the principles and policy priorities established by the Task Force through statewide outreach and messaging with business partners, policy makers, regulators and the public.
