Please be advised that Governor Polis shared an update on Colorado's Greenhouse Gas Pollution Reduction Roadmap at noon today. He was joined by members of the General Assembly, the clean energy and utility sector, and members of his Cabinet.

As a brief summary, the Governor announced the CO Gas Pollutions Reduction Roadmap, [which can be accessed here](#). He noted they have a very ambitious legislative agenda for 2021, accompanied by four major rule makings this year. The Governor also stated the PUC will be evaluating a number of emission control plans and utility retirement plans. The administration will advocate for the largest possible reductions possible while maintaining reliability in the most ambitious and expansive planning document to date, and the 80% electricity goal will be floor, not a ceiling.
